PREREQUISITES

Applicants who have a standard high school diploma or its equivalent from a regionally accredited institution, meet the state-mandated minimum basic skills requirements on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE), and interview with the program counselor may enter the program during the next enrollment period. All students must complete a drug screening, FDLE level 2 background screening, and physical examination with a completed immunization record prior to acceptance.

Distant/Hybrid Courses:

Students enrolled in distant and/or hybrid courses should have daily access to a computer with internet and must have a valid email address that they check daily. Additionally, students should have all necessary hardware and software components required by their technology program or adult education course.

Electrocardiograph Technology (EKG)



This program is designed to prepare students for employment as electrocardiograph aides, electrocardiograph technicians, EKG technicians, cardiovascular technologist and technicians or to provide supplemental training for persons previously or currently employed in this occupation. The content includes but is not limited to communications and interpersonal skills, human anatomy and physiology with emphasis on cardiac and vascular systems, medical terminology and transcription, patient care techniques, medical instrumentation, cardiovascular drugs, interpretation of monitoring and testing results, medical ethic, cardiac wellness and rehabilitation, safe and efficient work practices, CPR and employability skills.
