

Important Student Laptop Distribution Information for March 20, 2020

Greetings, McFatter Students and Parents:

Please remember that school is closed due to the coronavirus pandemic. In preparing to transition our courses to online instruction beginning March 30, we will be distributing laptops on campus on a first-come, first-served basis this Friday, from 8:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. We have 775 laptops available, with 600 high school students and more than 1200 adult students, so we respectfully request that you not sign out a device if you already have one available at home.

Adult students enrolled in Drafting, or in any program which uses Adobe software, should not report to campus on Friday for a device; please contact your instructor for information specific to your program.

For high school students needing a device, the parent/guardian must come to campus on Friday. The student ***may*** come, but is not required; however, the parent must have identification, and must have the student's ID number and district login password. The parent will be required to complete an online property pass; if you wish to fill out the pass in advance, the form can be found at <http://www.browardschools.com/bcpspropertypass> Please note that filling out the form in advance is ***not*** a reservation and does not guarantee you a device.

Adult students (who are not in Drafting or an Adobe-related program) requiring a laptop device do not fill out the online form, and are to report to campus on Friday with identification. Please have your student ID number and district login password with you.
