## Admissions Requirements

- 18 - 21 years of age
- Deferred Standard Diploma with a current IEP (Individual Education Plan).
- Expressed Interest in Paid Employment
- Demonstrates Employability Skills
- Ability and Desire to Independently navigate the community

## Course Content


- Career Placement is a work study transition service designed to assist students with a transitional Individualized Education Plan (IEP), to achieve their goals of independence and paid employment. Students are assisted in maintaining competitive entry level jobs in the private business sector. Career Placement Services enables students to identify career options, access community resources, and meet industry standards for entry level employment.
- Life skills necessary for success in the workplace and future independent living are included as part of the curriculum.
- Career placement students are provided with dedicated job coaches to assist them in obtaining and maintaining competitive paid employment.
- Through a collaborative effort, students will create their Transitional Individualized Education Plan (TIEP) to help them reach their goals.
