OPEN DOOR GRANT

Grant Overview

The Open Door Scholarship Program 2025-2026, funded by the Florida Department of Education, is designed to support students completing short-term and technical education credentialing courses. The grant covers 100% of the cost of tuition associated with the eligible courses, not otherwise covered by federal/state grants or other third-party payments.

Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms. Funds are subject to availability and will be awarded once the application is approved and all other aid is applied. Refer to application for more details.

Deadline

Submit applications in-person to Office of Student Financial Aid (Main Campus, Student Affairs – Building 1) by Friday, August 22, 2025 (12:00 PM). Applicants will be notified via email.

Requirements

1. Meet eligibility for Florida Residency for Tuition Purposes.
2. Enrolled in an eligible Career Technical Education (CTE) program (refer to next page for a list).
3. Enrolled in a course starting on August 11 – August 16, 2025.
4. Complete the 2025-26 FAFSA application process. Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term.

How to Apply

New Student

1. Complete the admissions process and receive an acceptance letter from the program counselor/advisor.
2. Submit the Open Door application (page 3) to the Office of Student Financial Aid to determine eligibility (Main Campus, Student Affairs - Building 1).

Returning Inactive Student

1. Contact the program counselor/advisor to discuss steps to re-enroll in the program.

- Applications must be submitted in-person to The Office of Student Financial Aid, Student Affairs (Building 1) no later than 12:00 PM on Friday, August 22, 2025.
- The Open Door Grant applies to eligible CTE programs and is currently being offered for courses starting August 11 – August 16, 2025 only.
- Students who are considered non-Florida residents for tuition purposes do not qualify even if receiving a fee exemption for out-of-state tuition fees.
- Open Door Grant funds are applied after federal and state aid, or third-party payments, to cover a maximum award equal to the amount needed to cover 100% of tuition for the term. McFatter Technical College is required to reduce or cancel the grant award if the student later becomes eligible for other financial assistance during the 2025-26 school year.
- Funds are subject to availability and priority is given to currently enrolled students.
- Notification of application status will be completed no later than Friday August 22, 2025. If awarded, funds must be used for the Fall term (Courses starting August 11- August 16, 2025) only. For current students, funds will be applied to the Focus student portal. New and returning inactive students will receive an award notification letter.
- Awarded funds only apply to the term for which the application is submitted. The student is responsible for the cost of subsequent terms.
- Qualified students who have already paid out-of-pocket for the Fall (Courses starting August11 – August 16, 2025) term, will be refunded eligible fees.
