Pursuant to State Board Rule 6A-10.040(8), in order to receive an exemption from basic skills testing, one of the following criteria must be met and presented to the Office of Admissions/Office Student Affairs:

- Evidence of official test scores pursuant to State Board Rule 6A-10.0315 that exempted the student from taking the Common Placement Test. To receive this exemption, the highest test scores on any of the tests or combination of tests shall be accepted. ***Individual student scores shall be valid for two (2) years starting from the earliest test date.** Only one comprehension area and one computation area may be used to demonstrate the required proficiency in Comprehension and Computation. **(Test History: Exemption – Test scores (TSE), Code: B)**

7. An official Enrollment Verification showing that the student is currently enrolled in an apprenticeship program registered with the Department of Education in accordance with Chapter 446, F.S. 8. An official passing test score on the test adopted by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission, pursuant to Section 943.17, F.S., and Rule 11B-35.0011, F.A.C., required for admission into law enforcement officer basic recruit training program (current test: CJBAT or BAT) or official enrollment verification for candidates entering the program. **{Test History: Exemption - Criminal Justice (CJE), Code: H}**
9. An official high school transcript or diploma from a private school that is accredited by an agency recognized by Broward Technical Colleges (BTC) and compliant with Section 1002.42, F.S. 11. Proof of registration from the district showing the student's enrollment in a personalized education program, along with signed and notarized BTC affidavit completed by the parent or legal guardian, attesting that the student has completed a home a personalized education program pursuant to Section 1002.395, F.S. **{Test History: Exemption - Personalized Ed (HSS), Code: S}**
12. An adult with a disability as defined in Section 1004.02(6), F.S., may be exempted from meeting the career basic skills grade levels required for completion of the career certificate program. Each school district and Florida college institution must adopt a policy addressing procedures for exempting eligible adults with disabilities from the basic skills exit requirements as permitted in Section 1004.91(3), F.S. Alternative assessments may also be used for adults with disabilities, as set forth in subsection (7). **{Test History: Exemption - ESE (ESE), Code: F}**
